Bulbophyllum pictum

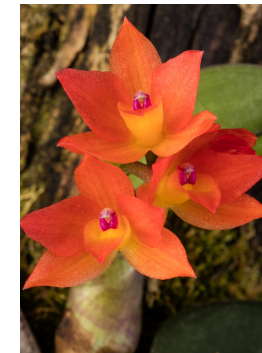


- Unpleasant smell

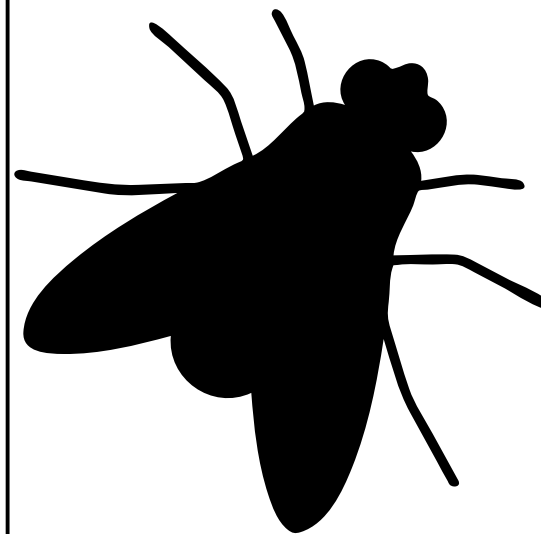
Hummingbirds

- Feed on nectar
- Long, dark-colored beaks
- Attracted to bright colors
- Limited sense of smell



*Wallace's Sphinx Moth
Xanthopan praedicta*

- Active at night
- Has a proboscis (tongue) that can range from 15–27 centimeters long



Flies

- Attracted to colors and scents reminiscent of carrion (decaying animals)
